

Greetings to all our Rock Island Residents,

Spring is here, and the sunshine is finally out! It's time to dust off those winter blues and embrace the new season with open arms. Speaking of embracing, did you know that you can save some cash by taking advantage of available property tax exemptions in Illinois? Let's dive into some of the most common ones:

First up, we have the General Homestead Exemption, which provides a reduction in property taxes for homeowners who occupy their homes as their principal residence. This exemption is available to all homeowners, regardless of age or income.

Next, we have the Senior Homestead Exemption, which provides an additional reduction in property taxes for homeowners who are 65 years or older. To qualify, you must own and occupy your home as your principal place of residence and your annual household income must be less than \$65,000.

Other property tax exemptions in Illinois include the Homestead Improvement Exemption, the Disabled Veterans' Standard Homestead Exemption, and the Disabled Persons Exemption.

Now that you have saved some money, lets talk about what to do with it! The city of Rock Island has many fun activities and events planned for the spring season. From the Quad Cities Symphony Orchestra concerts to the Farmer's Market at Lincoln Park, there's something for everyone. And if you're feeling adventurous, why not explore the beautiful parks and trails in the Township? There are plenty of scenic paths to explore on foot or bike, and plenty of playgrounds for kids to enjoy.

We hope you have a wonderful spring season, filled with sunshine, laughter, and good times. Remember to take advantage of the property tax exemptions available to you, and make the most of your savings by exploring all that Rock Island has to offer. Cheers to a great season ahead!

EXEMPTION REMINDERS

- If you are a new homeowner who just purchased your home and it was your principal residence on January 1st of this year, you should come in and sign up for the Owner/ Occupation exemption which will lower the bill
- If your 65th birthday is this year you will qualify for the Senior Homestead Exemption. You will need to bring proof of age when you apply.
- Disabled Persons Exemption




